Inauguration of the Grand Chancery

Friday 11th May 1973

The Grand Master, H.R.H. Prince Francisco Enrique de Borbon y de Borbon arrived accompanied by H.R.H. Princess Maria José de Borbon, H.R.H. Infante Don Enrique de Borbon, H.R.H. Prince Irakly de Bagration, Princess Dona Paz de Bagration de Baviera, H.E. the Marquis de Haro Union, Grand Referendary, Baille Don Rafael Gonzalez de Valls y Caballero; Dona Maria Francisca de Soler de Valls y Caballero and Don Salvador Floriach Ysbert de Gamanda.

They were met at the Airport by a distinguished delegation consisting of H.E. Col. Gayre of Gayre and Nigg, Grand Commander, and the Baroness of Lochore, Chev. J. Amato Gauci, Grand Chancellor, Col. the Chev. J. Abela, Delegate General Maltese Islands and Mrs. Abela, Chev. R. Basini, Prior, Malta Priory, Chev. A. Zammit, Secretary General, Malta Priory, Chev. R. Flores Martin and Mr. and Mrs. Lloyd.

In the evening the Grand Master, the Princess of Borbon, Prince and Princess Irakly de Bagration, and Marquis Haro de Union had dinner with the Laird and Lady of Gayre at Villa Lochore, at which Mr. Richard Flores Martin was present as interpreter. The purpose of the dinner was to prepare the proceedings for the events of the next day.

Saturday 12th May 1973

At 10 a.m. the Knights and Affiliates of the Order assembled in the Church of Our Lady at Mensija, and prayers were said by the Chaplains of the Order, namely Canon Wrangham Hardy, (Church of England), the Rev. J. M. Milne (Church of Scotland), the Very Rev. Archimandrite Peterfalvy, from Germany, (Orthodox Church), and the Creed was said by the Very Reverend Provost Monsignor Sciberras-Psaila, Senior Chaplain of the Order in Malta.

The Members of the Order proceeded in Procession to the Castell Lanzun, where the ladies and guests were assembled, in the order of Maltese Knights and Affiliates; Foreign Knights and Affiliates; High Officers of the Order; and the Grand Master,

the Grand Commander and Prince Bagration; with the rear brought up by the Clergy.

In the Court Yard of the Castello the Grand Master was welcomed by the Grand Commander in the following words:-

YOUR ROYAL HIGHNESS, AND GRAND MASTER,

It gives me great pleasure to welcome you and the distinguished company which has assembled here today in the Grand Chancery of our ancient Order of St. Lazarus of Jerusalem.

This Order which, despite its many vicissitudes, has continued far longer than any other Order without any break in its succession, has, nevertheless, been without a Chancery and property, since the last was forcibly taken from it at the French Revolution.

These times have now changed.

We have here in Malta established by decree of your predecessor, The Duke of Nemours, the Grand Chancery of the Order. The work of furnishing a building has now been achieved in the Castell Lanzun. From this seat the Order will be administered.

In addition, other buildings have been acquired. Captain Mingo Sweeney of Bolger's Park has the Commandery of the Holy Trinity in Canada, and in Edinburgh there exists the Church of St. Vincent and the Church hall. In addition to these buildings we now have active ambulance corps. The Commandery of Lochore has six ambulances; it has been able to equip Northern Ireland with three in addition, and Malta with one, and in New Zealand there is also an ambulance corps. Besides all this, there have been substantial funds raised this year for leprosy work overseas in which the American Grand Priory has played a leading part.

The Order is once more regaining its strength. Its Titular Seat lies in Madrid, the Seat of Your Royal Highness, the Titular Commandery of the Grand Master is Boigny, in France, and here we have the Seat of the Administration, where the day to day business of the Order is transacted.

As Grand Commander and Grand Almoner of the Order, entrusted with its administration, with the able assistance of the Grand Chancellor, the Chevalier Amato Gauci, we bid you welcome on this auspicious occasion, and the distinguished company you have brought with you, as well as the other delegates from the numerous priories and commanderies who are assembled here today.

The Grand Master gave his Commission to the Laird of Gayre, as Grand Commander, in which he confirmed his Grand Cross of Justice with Collar, to the Chevalier Amato Gauci in which he promoted him to Knight Grand Cross of Justice with Collar, and to the Marquis Haro de Union whom he created Knight Grand Cross of Justice with Collar.

This was followed by the Blessing of the Chapel, in which Canon Gordon Hyslop took part.

Meanwhile, through the good offices of Monsignor Sciberras-Psaila, the Papal Blessing had been received, and was affixed to the wall of the Chapel.

The Grand Chancellor then addressed the Grand Master and the distinguished members present, as follows:-

Your Royal Highness, Your Highness, Excellencies, Confreres and Consoeurs,

His Excellency the Grand Commander, the Laird of Gayre and Nigg, who owned this estate, informed me in 1971 that he intended donating the use of the Castell ta' Lanzun, then in ruins, to the Order for use as its Headquarters.

He further undertook to restore the building to its former state, and even carry out improvements, at his own expense.

The work which was entrusted to a local firm under the direct supervision of Chev. Maurice Captur, Architect and Civil Engineer, proceeded apace and, by the beginning of the year, all reconstruction work was completed.

Then began the fitting and furnishing of the Grand Chancery, which was carried out thanks to the generosity of our Confreres, and in particular those of the American

Grand Priory who contributed lavishly to the Headquarters Fund.

It is not possible for me here to thank individually all those who made donations in kind or in cash or who offered free their professional services. Suffice to say that the response to our appeal exceeded all expectations. To H.E. the Grand Commander and to all those who in one way or another made it possible for the Order to have its permanent Headquarters I say thank you in the name of our beloved Order.

I now call upon H.E. the Grand Referendary to unveil this tablet.

The Grand Referendary then unveiled the plaque and read the inscription in Spanish.

Following this there was a tour of the Castle, at the end of which the Grand Commander and Lady of Gayre gave a reception to all the members present.

Saturday Evening

A grand gala dinner was given at the Casino Maltese, at which over 120 members and guests participated.

During the Dinner, in appreciation of his work as Grand Referendary and his munificence, the Grand Master invested The Laird of Gayre with the Cordon of the Cross of Merit in the highest grade.

Sunday Morning

At 10 a.m. a preliminary meeting with the Grand Master, Grand Commander, Prince Irakly de Bagration, the Grand Referendary, the Grand Chancellor, and Mr. Flores Martin occurred.

The Grand Master announced that the Administration of the Order would continue as at present, and only where matters not covered by existing decrees were involved, would either the Grand Commander write to the Grand Master or the Grand Chancellor to the Grand Referendary for instructions.

A Chapter General was held at 11 a.m.

The result of this is that the Grand Commander announced the gift to the Order of Lochore House, with five flats, next to Villa Lochore. The method of handling over the property would be left to Notary Dr. J. Grech CLJ, and Mr. Harold Farrugia OLJ to work out in the best interest of the Order.

Following the Chapter General a Cold Buffet Lunch was served.

Sunday Afternoon

At 5.30 p.m. the members gathered at the Hospital of St. Catherine in order to make a donation of an Ambulance from the Priory of Malta. It had been brought from the Commandery of Lochore, Scotland, by Messrs. Chalmers and Hardie. The Ambulance was blessed by Monsignor Sciberras-Psaila; the Grand Master, presented it to the Hospital, and he invested the Rev. Fr. Ciantar O.P. as Assistant Chaplain; the Rev. Mothers Columba Camilleri and Clelia Blye as an officer and member of the Companionate of Merit respectively.

The Grand Commander presented Messrs. Chalmers and Hardie with the Order's cuff links.

The Grand Master unveiled a plaque commemorating the event and the hospital has undertaken to fly the Flag of St. Lazarus on St. Lazarus Day (17th December) each year, as well as to name the new wing of the hospital after the patron saint of the Order.

Sunday Evening

At 7 p.m. a reception was given by the Priory of Malta at the Palazzo Parisio to the foreign guests and members of the Priory.

Monday, 14th May at 7 p.m.

The Grand Commander and Madam Gayre of Gayre and Nigg gave a reception for the heads of delegations, and the organising committee, to meet the Grand Master and his party.

Tuesday, 15th May

The Grand Master and his suite left for Spain and were seen off by the Grand Commander and the Chev. and Mrs. Amato Gauci.
